Introduction to Tianjin Investment Environment





Tianjin is one of the four municipalities directly under the central government, the gateway to the capital Beijing and the economic center of Bohai-Rim region with a population of 13.76 million.

If you take the high-speed train from Beijing, it only takes 30 minutes to Tianjin. Tianjin is a city with a story, and many major events in modern history are related to this city. In the new era, Tianjin continues to accelerate the transformation of its development mode, continuously promote the transformation of old and new driving forces, and vigorously improve its business environment, demonstrating a new charm.





Tianjin: A City of Vitality

The development positioning of Tianjin given by the central government of China is "one base and three zones". In the past 10 years, Tianjin has adhered to the new development concept. The city's GDP has steadily increased, the modern industrial system has been gradually improved, and economic and social development has fully entered a high-quality track. The new era has given Tianjin new vitality. Such major strategic opportunities overlap as the coordinated development of Beijing, Tianjin and Hebei region, the development of the Belt and Road Initiative and the building of a new development paradigm. The unique geographical advantage, the port advantage of connecting inside and outside, the strong industrial advantage, the science and education advantage of talent accumulation, the leading advantage of reform and opening up, and the profound cultural advantage are speeding up their transformation into a strong driving force for high-quality development. In the first quarter of 2023, Tianjin's GDP grew by 5.5%, ranking seventh among 31 provinces, autonomous regions and municipalities, and first among municipalities directly under the central government.

Tianjin: A City Open to the World

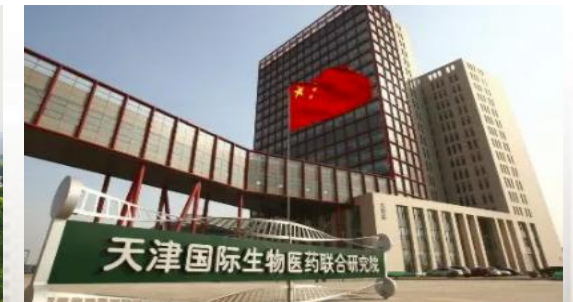
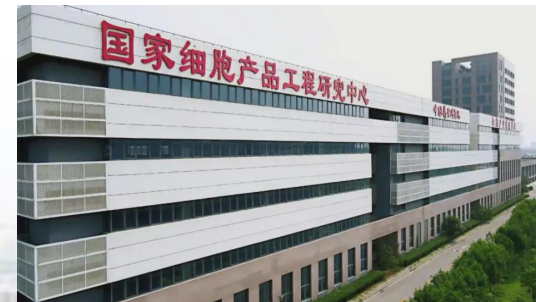
Tianjin is one of the first coastal open cities in China, with the most complete form of special economic zones. In the past 5 years, 3609 new foreign-invested enterprises were established in Tianjin, with an actual use of foreign investment of 25.4 billion USD and an average annual growth rate of 6.7%. At present, 269 *Fortune 500* companies have settled in Tianjin. In the first quarter of this year, the actual use of foreign investment was 2.07 billion USD, with an increase of 12.8%. In the past five years, Tianjin's foreign trade has been running at a high level, with total imports and exports increasing by 4.6%. In the first quarter of this year, foreign trade continued to show a stable and positive trend. Tianjin and EU have close economic and trade exchanges. There are over 600 EU-invested enterprises in the city, with an annual operating income of over 220 billion RMB and nearly 55 thousand employees. EU is Tianjin's largest trading partner. In 2022, the bilateral import and export trade volume reached 197.7 billion RMB, with a year-on-year increase of 4%, accounting for about a quarter of the city's total foreign trade volume.





Tianjin: A City of Innovation

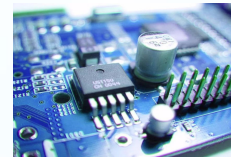
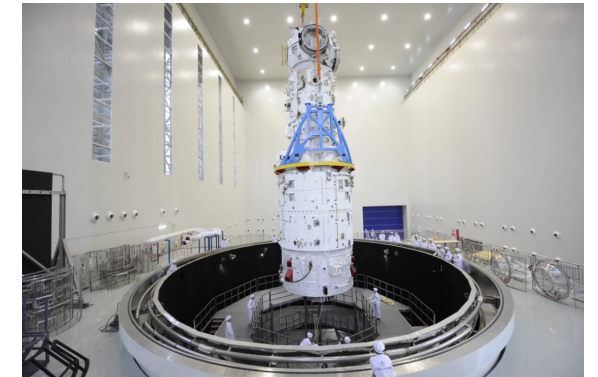
Tianjin has numerous national and ministry-level laboratories, engineering technology research centers and enterprise technology centers, with a total of over 170 national level institutes and high-level research and development institutions in China. Among them, there are 71 national level enterprise technology centers, ranking third among key cities in China. Six Haihe Laboratories including information and innovation, synthetic biology, cell ecology, brain-machine interaction and human-machine integration have been built at a high level, bringing together over 3000 outstanding talents. The overall R&D investment intensity in society has reached 3.66%, ranking third nationwide. A large number of independent innovation achievements such as "Tianhe-1" supercomputing, Phytium CPU and Kylin OS have become the new business cards of Tianjin. The Tiankai Higher Education Science and Technology Innovation Park was opened on May 18th. The Park has registered over 280 enterprises, signed contracts with 104 financial institutions, and settled in 80 scientific and technological innovation institutions.





Tianjin: A City of Industry

Tianjin has all 44 industrial categories, making it a city with the most complete industrial system in China. In 2021, Tianjin issued the "14th Five-Year-Plan" for high-quality development of manufacturing industry, with the strategic focus on building a "1+3+4" industrial system. "1" refers to intelligent technology, "3" refers to the three emerging industries of biopharmaceuticals, new energy and new materials, and "4" refers to the four advantageous industries of aerospace, high-end equipment, automobiles, and petroleum and petrochemical. Meanwhile, 12 key industrial chains were selected, and a "chain leader system" has been implemented. In 2022, the 12 key industrial chains continues play its "cornerstone" role, with a value-added industrial output accounting for 77.9% of industries above designated size, driving an increase of 5.2 percentage points compared to the previous year.





Tianjin: A City of Transportation Hub

Tianjin has the largest modern comprehensive port in northern China, with access to over 500 ports in over 180 countries and regions. In 2022, the container throughput of Tianjin Port exceeded 21.5 million TEUs, ranking eighth globally. Currently, we are promoting the deep integration of port, industry and city, and vigorously accelerating the development of port economy. Tianjin's modern transportation network is crisscrossed and well-connected. Tianjin has 317 kilometers of high-speed and intercity railways, ranking first in the country in terms of density. The accumulated mileage of the expressway is 1355 kilometers, ranking second nationwide. Tianjin Binhai International Airport is a major airport in China and one of the major air cargo centers. It is currently undergoing the third phase of renovation and expansion project, which will have a passenger throughput capacity of 70 million people and has been selected as one of the first national logistics hubs in the 14th Five Year Plan.





Tianjin: A City of Commerce & Trade

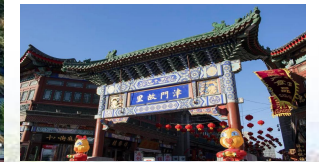

In the central urban area, Tianjin is building a high standard financial street and characteristic themed buildings, focusing on developing a number of industrial clusters such as modern commerce, characteristic finance, headquarters economy, high-end commerce, shipping services, cultural and creative design, and enhancing industrial capabilities.
